DID YOU KNOW THAT SPIŠSKÁ NOVÁ VES HAS ITS OWN SEVEN WONDERS?

Residents and visitors have suggested notable and unique sights that add to the appeal and visibility of Spišská Nová Ves. A survey resulted in the following ranking:

- The Roman Catholic parish church of the Assumption of the Virgin
 Mary features the tallest church tower in Slovakia. Inside this 14th-century
 church, visitors can admire the Crucifixion sculpture crafted by Master
 Paul of Levoča. The tower is accessible for climbing year-round,
 with guided tours arranged by the Tourist Information Centre.
- The square boasts a unique lens-shaped design, setting it apart as one of Slovakia's most picturesque and Europe's longest of its kind. Discover delightful nooks and inviting seating areas beneath the shade of trees or on the cozy terraces of its vibrant restaurants and cafes.
- 3. The Art Nouveau Reduta building, dating from the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries, is home not only to the Spiš Theatre but also to a lavishly adorned concert hall. This hall is a favored locale for diverse events and celebrations. Additionally, the building accommodates a restaurant and office spaces.
- 4. The Provincial House with Levoča Gate, once a town hall and later the seat of the Province of 16 Spiš towns, is distinguished by its front façade adorned with six rococo cartouches symbolizing the virtues expected of town officials. Today, the building is home to the Museum of Spiš.
- 5. The classical Town Hall, dating back to the 18th century, serves as the seat of the mayor's office. Its most captivating feature is the magnificent ceremonial hall spanning two floors, hosting a variety of events such as ceremonial receptions for quests, jubilees, weddings, and concerts.
- 6. The Spiš market, steeped in tradition brings alive the charm of centuries-old town fairs with its rich entertainment offerings. This celebrated four-day event promises a dynamic cultural lineup, bustling vendor stalls, and a myriad of delightful attractions, including whimsical carousel.
- 7. The striking mosaic in the Temple of the Transfiguration, crafted from natural materials following the style of Father Mark Rupnik from Centro Aletti in Rome, is a sight to behold.

 Father Rupnik's works are also showcased in notable locations such as Lourdes, Fatima, and the Vatican. This mosaic vividly portrays

key scenes from the Christian faith.



DISCOVER THE SECRETS OF CONRAD THE BELL-RINGER



Master Konrád possessed an unparalleled skill in metalwork, enchanting all with his craftsmanship. Alongside his brothers, he established Spiš's first Gothic bell foundry, where bells and baptismal fonts were cast. Today, these flawless and melodious bells still resonate in various places. In Spišská Nová Ves, you can witness and hear these timeless artifacts. Make sure not to miss the opportunity to ascend the tallest church tower in Slovakia, which not only houses invaluable treasures but also offers breathtaking views

of the town and surrounding mountains. As you explore the square,

venture into the depths of the memorial at the **Place of Wishes**, where you can make a wish and send it skyward with the ringing of a bell. Listen to the story of Konrád (see QR Code).



This summer, we're making it easier than ever to explore our beautiful region. Partnering with eurobus a.s., IDS Východ integrated transport system, and Košice Region Tourism, we're excited to introduce the SUMMER BUS. Running from June 29 to September 1, this service on lines 810436 and 810438 will whisk you between northern and southern Slovenský raj via the scenic Kopanec saddle. Enjoy convenient transportation and even bring your bike along for the adventure.

The buses, equipped with a bike trailer capable of carrying 15 bikes, cater not only to cyclists but also to hikers with seating for 26 passengers and standing room for 6. Here are the routes:

SUMMER TRAIN LINES



Each year, Železničná spoločnosť Slovensko (Railway Company Slovakia), in collaboration with Ministry of Transport of the Slovak Republic and regional tourism organizations, introduces a selection of captivating summer train, to support turismus.

VIA FERRATA KYSEĽ

In recent years, true adventurers have been drawn to the Kysel' Ferrata operated by the Mountain Rescue Service. The thrilling pathway reopening the Kysel Gorge after four decades following a devastating fire. As the sole accessible gorge in the Slovak Paradise via this route, it stands as a breathtaking showcase of the national park's natural beauty. Untouched by human hands since the 1976 fire, this pristine wilderness has flourished, captivating nature enthusiasts and prompting dedicated efforts from park rangers to safeguard its ecological integrity. As the gorge is nestled deep within the national park, expect a 1.5-hour hike just to reach it. The remaining two hours are dedicated to navigating the via ferrata. Crossing times vary significantly based on water levels, weather conditions, and the number of hikers, so plan a full day for this adventure. For those seeking more after conquering Ferrata Kysel, explore further into the Vel'ký and Malý Kysel branches from its summit. Discover captivating waterfalls and narrow passages where ferrata equipment is not required. The Ferrata is open annually from June 15th to October 31st, The fee for using equipment in the gorges of the Slovak Paradise National Park

WHAT THE ROCK OF THE CARTHUSIAN MONKS' "SKALA ÚTOČISKA" IN SLOVAK PARADISE HIDES?

Once a refuge during epidemics and devastating wars, today it stands as a major tourist hub in Slovak Paradise. This is the legendary Kláštorisko, nestled on its namesake plateau within the national park. Each year, countless visitors are drawn to its historic ruins, the remnants of a Carthusian monastery from the late 13th century, where monks briefly found solace for their ascetic lives. Remarkably, evidence of settlement at this site dates back to the Bronze Age? Approximately 3,000 years



ago, a substantial fortified settlement existed on this site. This rich historical background makes it a "paradise" for historians and archaeologists, who continue to uncover and study valuable artifacts from ancient times.

In the Middle Ages, the monastery served as a refuge for more than just monks. Whenever a dangerous disease or military conflict swept through Spiš, local people would find shelter and safety there. This earned it the Latin name "Lapis Refugii" - Skala útočiska (the Rock of Refuge). The Carthusians later named the entire area around the monastery "Paradisus" - Paradise, a name that has endured to this day. What can you do and experience at the Kláštorisko today? Start by enjoying a delicious refreshment and recharging your energy at the Kláštorisko Buffet, managed by the municipality of Letanovce. Then, visit the Symbolic Cemetery, dedicated to the victims of Slovenský raj and to the individuals who have significantly contributed to

its preservation. Lastly, explore the Carthusian monastery, which is currently being restored Letanovce, thanks in part to this year's National Project People and Castles. Through this initiative, the municipality aims to gradually establish a modern archeopark - a vibrant openair museum that will present a slice of precious history in an engaging and contemporary manner. Near the monastery, a herb garden featuring various medicinal and ornamental plants has been created and is maintained by the Civic Association Verbum Bonum from Spišské Tomášovce. After exploring the monastery, you can choose from numerous hiking and cycling trails that extend in all directions and continue your adventure. klastorisko.sk

SLOVAK PARADISE NATIONAL PARK **AUTHORITY**

The official nature conservation authority.

Its primary mission revolves around mapping, managing, and

safeguarding the natural treasures within the national park. Additionally, it engages in cultural, educational.promotional.and editorial initiatives related to nature and landscape conservation. The organization oversees the enforcement of Visitor Regulations through park rangers and plays an active role in managing tourism within the region. The organization directly oversees the Ferrata HZS Kysel and organizes rafting excursions through the Hornád Canyon. The organization has developed an audio tour of Slovenský raj - South Nature Trail accessible via the SmartGuide application. It manages its own tourist information center in Podlesok and operates the Prvosienka Environmental Education Centre situated in Spišská Nová Ves.

10 VISITOR'S **RULES**



- **1.** Hiking trails in Slovenský raj are open year-round, except for Ferrata Kysel', which closes annually from November 1st to June 14th. However, traversing the gorges can be challenging, necessitating sturdy footwear.
- 2. An adequately equipped hiker should wear sturdy footwear, preferably Vibram shoes, appropriate clothing, have a raincoat, a map, a water bottle or thermos, a mobile phone for emergency calls, a flashlight or headlamp, a first aid kit, and mountain insurance.
- 3. For safety reasons, traversing the gorges is only permitted in the upstream direction, opposite the flow of the stream, unlike the other routes.
- Due to weather conditions, the gorges may become impassable and subsequently closed. Information regarding trail accessibility can be obtained from hzs.sk, information centers, or signage at the gorge
- You should start your hike earlier as you will have enough time to return during day light.
- Please be mindful of others when enjoying nature for relaxation. Loud behavior disrupts wildlife and detracts from the experience of fellow visitors. Additionally, extended photo sessions on ladders can cause delays and
- 7. Dispose of your waste responsibly as garbage bins and bags can draw wildlife. Please, take your leftovers with you.
- 8. Avoid fire risks; dispose of cigarette butts and glass bottles properly. Fires should only be started in designated areas at trailheads.
- 9. Dogs must be on a leash and wear a muzzle while in the national park. They are not able to cross ladders in
- **10.** Camping, overnight stays, or bivouacking are only permitted in designated campsites.

Respect the visitor regulations and remain on the marked trails and cycle paths. Visitors are urged to consider obtaining insurance in case they require assistance from the Mountain Rescue Service.

EXPERIENCE SPIŠ ON BIKE

Southern Spiš boasts **over 600 kilometers** of picturesque cycling trails, with nearly 110 km traversing through Slovak Paradise National Park. Portions of these routes are integrated into the **Spišská** or **Hnilecká cycling networks**, categorized into various difficulty levels. Begin your cycling journey from Spišská Nová Ves, Gelnica, or the villages of Hnilčík and Poráč. **Experienced cyclists** often enjoy merging multiple routes to craft their own circuits. From the saddle of a bicycle, you can venture through various regions of the Slovak Paradise, such as the **Galmus Mountains**, the **Palcmanská Maša dam**, and numerous **awe-inspiring vistas** from both small and large hills.

How to choose the right trail?

Cycling in Slovenský raj is accessible even for less experienced cyclists, provided you select your route wisely and gauge your abilities realistically. The cycling guide categorizes routes based on difficulty levels. Beginners and families with children are encouraged to opt for easier routes labeled "REKREA". Cyclists with moderate fitness can challenge themselves on routes classified as "SPORT". The "EXPERT" adventures are reserved for seasoned cycling professionals.

The new cycling guide for the South Spiš cycling region features 19 comprehensive cycling loops along with the complete Spišská or

Hnilecká cycling networks, It includes detailed maps, route parameters, elevation profiles, and photographs highlighting points of interest along each circuit. Additionally, the guide provides recommendations for dining and accommodation choices in the region.

CHARGING STATIONS



The Association of Municipalities Microregion Slovak Paradise - North has completed a project to build bicycle rest areas and charging stations in the Slovak Paradise area, supported by the Košice Self-Governing Region's Terra Incognita subsidy program. This initiative has enhanced the appeal of the destination by creating a network of rest areas and charging stations.

Visitors can take advantage of a rest area equipped with a litter bin, a regional map, and bicycle racks, including a charging station for e-bikes. Charging e-bikes is free for cyclists and the station offers five different charging connectors, a compressor for inflating tires, and a basic tool kit. Additionally, the panel features a touchscreen display with essential touring information.



WHAT ŠKOLSKÁ DIERA HIDES?

Behind this mysterious name lies a cave



where archaeologists discovered engraved initials dating back to the 16th century. Locally known as Karas's Hole, legend has it that the brigand Karas once hid here. The cave is situated in **Schulerloch**, a popular suburban sports and recreation area. Enhance your explorations in this area by visiting the nearby **shooting range** and **the ÚŽ-6 military bunker**, where you can view authentic military artifacts from the 1960s to the 1980s. The hiking trail also leads to the Slovak Double Cross and **the lookout tower** on Schulerloch Hill.

SCENIC SPOTS TO VISIT

head to the outskirts of Spišská Nová Ves. Here, atop Pieskovec Hill, stands a 10-meter-high Slovak double cross, a striking symbol of Slovak statehood, erected in 2008.

Located just 300 meters from the car park at the Dobšinská Ice Cave, this adventure park lets you test your bravery on a 350-meter-long course with obstacles set high in the treetops. For children, there's a less demanding, 108-meter track, perfect for young

adventurers. Experienced instructors will ensure your safety and provide belaying during your climb. After exploring Tarzania, you can boost your adrenaline further on the unique Wetlands of Hnilec Nature Trail, which features benches directly over the wetlands. Alternatively, you can enjoy the new Dobšinský chotár Nature Trail, which highlights the region's mining history and natural beauty

SLEEPING IN THE HAY



Have you ever slept in the hay? Or have you only heard such romantic tales from your grandparents and now want to experience it yourself? Visit **Chata Horáreň** in Slovak Paradise. IN THE ICE KINGDOM

In Slovak Paradise National Park, there's a spot where you can escape into a winter wonderland, even amidst the hottest summer days. This enchanting place is none other than the renowned Dobšinská Ice Cave. where ice formations have been shaping its interior for tens of thousands of years. What awaits you when you explore this natural marvel? The Dobšinská Ice Cave, designated as a National Natural Monument, has been on UNESCO's prestigious World List of Natural Monuments since 2000, boasting several World Heritage sites. This cave holds the distinction of being the world's deepest ice cave with the largest volume of ice. Opened to the public in 1871, it pioneered electric lighting in European caves by 1887. In its history, it hosted summer ice skating events, attracting renowned figure skaters like European champion Karol Divín for training.



Dress appropriately for the cave's cold environment, where temperatures stay around zero degrees Celsius all year. Don't forget to wear sturdy footwear, as the tour involves climbing up to 500 steps along the 475-meter circuit through the cave. The entire tour lasts approximately 30 minutes. The Dobšinská Ice Cave welcomes visitors from 15th May to 15th September, open daily except Mondays. Follow the blue hiking trail which

includes the Dobšinská Ice Cave Nature Trail, leading directly from the Tourist Information Centre's parking lot to the cave in under half an hour. The trail features 5 stops perfect for brief rests during the ascent to the cave, each supplemented with an educational exhibition at the cave entrance. You can also take a short detour to explore the intriguing Dobšinský chotár nature trail, which delves into the area's mining history.

WINTER IN SLOVAK PARADISE AND SOUTHERN SPIS

If you choose to visit our region in winter, you'll discover a variety of ski resorts and kilometers of cross-country ski trails in Grajnár, Poráč,

and the multi-purpose complex Schulerloch. Join the Winter Ski Challenge to explore the stunning routes and views of the Spiš region. For a thrilling



winter adventure, try ice climbing in the National Park from December 1 to March 15, with opportunities in Suchá Bela, Kláštorská roklina,

Sokolia dolina, Letanovský Mlyn, Zejmarská roklina, and Piecky. During long winters, typically in early February, the Hornád Canyon

VISITING THE COUNT

Step into the world of rich noblemen from centuries past at the Renaissance manor house of the Máriássy family in Markušovce. 
Families with children are encouraged to explore the Forestry Nature Trail Diana in the Novoveská Huta district. Spanning approximately 2,200 meters, this trail includes 5 themed stops, a wooden gazebo, informative panels, and natural educational features like a tree traffic light. Beginning

as a blue trail and later transitioning to green, the hike starts at Medvedá dolka, across from Sádrovka in Novoveská Huta. The entire loop takes about 2 hours to complete. the premises. Reach the

The ancient chapel, known locally as the the

village of Iliašovce. In the 18th century, Count Czáky constructed a summer palace with expansive grounds here—a place renowned for its entertainment and luxury. However, the count's extravagant lifestyle led to financial ruin, and marital issues prompted him to sell off the lavish furnishings and eventually demolish the buildings. Following years of neglect, the Civic Association Sans Souci - Letohrádok Iliašovce initiated the renovation of the chapel. Today, it stands as an ideal spot for leisure with family and friends, perfect for roasting delicacies or simply enjoying the shade of the trees. Additionally, visitors can discover a land-art installation called Fig pit on

As our third recommendation for a scenic walk, begin your adventure in the Košiarny Briežok suburban recreation area. The yellow trail ascends gently on an asphalt road to Bear's Head saddle (Medvedia hlava). From there, a forest path leads to the Matka Božia point,



where you'll be rewarded with beautiful views of the Lesnice valley and the High Tatras. The round trip takes less than 3 hours.

THE MYSTERY OF THE VILLAGE OF MILOJ

Spiš boasts not only the tallest church tower in Slovakia, which stands in Spišská Nová Ves,



but also the most enigmatic one-the stone ruin of the vanished village of Miloj. According to legend, the village was condemned to hell because its inhabitants lived sinfully and indulged in excess. The tower remains as a reminder for sinners to abide by God's rules. The lost village, located in the Ku koscilku area, is recorded in history as early as 1255 under the name Terra Miloj. The name Miloj, meaning "something nice," suggests that the village once was. Curious about the fate of the village of Miloj? Historian Miroslav Števík unravels this ancient mystery in his article (scan the QR code for more details). To visit the tower yourself, you can take a 15-minute walk from the edge of Spišský Hrušov or follow the green cycle route 5712, which connects Spišský Hrušov and Domaňovce. The tower's symbol also features in the logo of the local action group (LAG) Miloj Spiš, o.z., dedicated to integrated rural development.



EXPLORE SPORTS OPTIONS AROUND THE DOBŠINSKÁ ICE CAVE

The **Sports Club Dobšiná** fosters various athletic initiatives near Dobšiná and in the southern Slovenský raj region. Annually, it hosts a nationally recognized cross-country race. The route for the Beh v raji (Run in Paradise), established in 2015, features minimal elevation changes and winds through the scenic landscapes within the Slovak Paradise National Park: from the Stratensky Canyon in the Hnilec Valley, between the Duča and Havrania skala massifs. The race marks the commencement of the tourist season in May. During autumn, the sports club hosts the Dobšinská desiatka (Dobšinská Ten) forest race. Participants can choose between 10 km and 7 km tracks, featuring nearly 400 meters of elevation gain, along with a Nordic walking category. Additionally, the club provides Nordic walking courses led by seasoned instructors.

MINING AT SPIŠ



predates its earliest written records, as evidenced by archaeological discoveries revealing local metallurgical activities. These findings primarily relate to the processing of metals discovered in the Hornádská kotlina (basin), possibly dating back to the Iron and Bronze Ages. The compact yet highly engaging mining exhibition situated in the heart of Spišská Nová Ves presents visitors with permanent displays, showcasing minerals, rock formations, and a surveying-geological exhibition.



EDUCATIONAL TRAILS: MINING LEGACY IN SPIŠ REGION

Discover a wealth of intriguing insights into past mining activities right at their historical sites. One such example is the **Mining Trail from Spišská Nová Ves to Novoveská Huta**. Spanning three routes beneath Muráň Hill, this trail features 7 stops equipped with informative panels. These panels delve into the region's mining history, covering copper and iron ore mining, uranium, gypsum, notable mining structures, and the history of the abandoned Novoveská Huta spa. You can also learn about the narrow-gauge railway that once traversed the Rybníky valley to the base of Čertova hlava.

Explore remarkable sites and historical landmarks tied to mining history across southern Spiš. Have you ever seen a Pochwerk mining machine or a mining smelter? These fascinating artifacts can be discovered at the Mining Museum in the historic royal mining town of **Gelnica**. Established in 1938, the **Gelnica Mining Museum** offers insights into the region's rich mining heritage and features the **Mining Educational Trail**. A highlight of this trail is the **Jozef Heritage Tunnel**, where visitors can peer directly into the underground mine accompanied by a knowledgeable guide. It's an unforgettable experience suitable for all ages. **Dobšiná** beckons

you to explore the **Educational Trail tracing the footsteps of mining in the area**. Divided into two branches, this trail winds through picturesque landscapes, offering not only a delightful stroll but also insights into key locations and technical structures linked to local mining activities.






The **Poráč mine** was the final active deep mine in the Spišská Nová Ves Iron Mines, ceasing operations in June 2019. The municipality maintains the original state of the Poráč mine building, open to the public and enhanced by sinkholes along the former mining path on the



pit's surface. In **Poráčská dolina (valley)**, there's a newly established **mining museum**, featuring the accessible 130-meter-long **Peter tunnel** and a mining water attraction adjacent to the museum. The **mining educational trail** begins at the museum, with seven stops highlighting the Poráč area.



A scenic hiking trail also leads to the captivating Markušovský sklaný hríb rock formation (Mushroom rock). During winter, visitors are treated to the enchanting sight of the Šikľavá skala icefall, resembling a scene straight out of a fairy tale.




